CAMP PHILOSPHY

CAMP FORMAT

The format of the 2009 Mullen Mustang Youth Football Camp will consist of individual instruction of basic fundamental skills and individual and team competition. The campers, broken down by position and age, will receive instruction in an offensive and defensive position with the focus on drills that enhance the fundamentals of football at those positions. In conjunction with the instruction the campers receive, they will have the opportunity to compete for many awards in different age groups and categories as well as compete in a team environment. The week culminates with a Championship Day where individual and team champions are declared. Enrollment is limited to ensure a 12 to 1 coach-to-camper ratio, so do not delay in signing up for the best camp in Denver.

In conjunction to learning about football, your young athlete will also be introduced to the proper training techniques in regard to conditioning, weight training, and nutrition by professionals in their respected fields. Not to be overlooked, the attitude in which one plays the game will be stressed throughout the week in individual and team settings.
